ITINERARY & IMPORTANT INFO

DAY 1 - ARRIVE IN AUCKLAND

• AUCKLAND Kia ora! Touching down in New Zealand's largest city, we'll meet you at our centrally located hostel to settle in. This evening you'll meet up with the rest of your travel crew and excited for all the adventures to come in Aotearoa.

DAY 2 - GLOWWORM CAVES & HOBBITON

• ROTORUA First up we're stopping at Waitomo, home of the world-famous glowworm caves. We'll take a guided tour and explore this labyrinth of underground rivers and watch the resident glowworms do their thing. This afternoon we tick off another highlight as we head to Hobbiton to wander the real-life lush pastures of the Shire as featured in The Lord of The Rings and The Hobbit trilogies. After exploring the set and learning all about movie magic, we'll enjoy a drink at the Green Dragon Inn before departing for Rotorua.

DAY 3 - EXPLORE ROTORUA

• ROTORUA Waking up to the whiff of sulphur, today you'll definitely know you're in Rotorua! We'll visit the naturally heated waters of Kerosene Creek where you'll get to take a dip, as well one of New Zealand's most magnificent geothermal wonderlands – Wai o Tapu, featuring dramatic geysers & bubbling mud.

DAY 4 - MĀORI CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

• ROTORUA This morning you'll have some free time to maybe try some zorbing or the skyline luge. In the evening we'll go to the Mitai Māori village for an introduction to Māori culture. It doesn't get more authentic than this!

DAY 5 - TAUPO & SAIL

• TAUPO Have your cameras ready as we travel to Taupo, a lakefront town in the heart of the North Island. This afternoon we'll treat you to something special - a sailing trip across the lake. Swoon over spectacular, no-filter-needed scenery.

DAY 6 - WATERFALLS & ADRENALINE

• TAUPO This morning we're off on a scenic walk to check out Huka Falls, a goose-bump inducing torrent of crystal water thundering down the Waikato River that you will hear before you see. After witnessing the raw power of Mother Nature, you'll then have some free time when you can do a skydive or a bungee jump!

DAY 7 - TRAVEL TO WELLINGTON

• WELLINGTON Today we'll head to New Zealand's capital city, Wellington! Dive into the city's energy by exploring its charming cafes, indulging in delicious bites at top-notch restaurants or kicking back and soaking up the laid-back vibes of the evening.

DAY 8 - EXPLORE WELLINGTON

• WELLINGTON Get ready to explore the best of Wellington with a city orientation tour! Hop aboard the iconic cable cars for stunning views, then dive into the rich history and vibrant culture at Te Papa Tongarewa Museum—ranked among the world's best museums.

DAY 9 - FLY TO CHRISTCHURCH

Later, we'll tackle the Mount Iron hike, where we'll be rewarded with breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape, including the Pisa Range and the Upper Clutha Basin.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

It's best to arrive on the actual start date, as that's when most people get in. While there are no activities on the first day, the group usually meets up for dinner around 7pm. If you do arrive early, you can book and pay for extra nights of the accommodation we use in the Manage My Booking area.

We'll make sure you're comfortable with what you're doing, where you're going and help you with everything you'll need to have the trip of a lifetime with the new friends you've made. Those on the NZ Intro work add-on will get lots of help with finding work, accommodation and onward travel.

VISAS

If you're planning a short holiday and are from Australia, the UK, Canada, USA, or any of the countries on this list, you do not need a visa to enter but do require an NZ ETA (New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority) which can be requested online. We can help organise this before you go.

If you are doing the NZ Intro work add-on you will need a Working Holiday Visa. A WHV is usually available to those aged 18 - 30 (or up to 35 for certain countries) and valid for 12 or 23 months (or 36 months if you are from UK).

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Your group leader will ask to see proof of your cover before your trip begins. You can organise travel insurance here or contact us.

If you're going to be working in NZ, you'll need an NZ bank account. To open your bank account just go to the 'Manage My Booking' section of our website. Your bank account will be set up with Wise. NZ employers will be able to pay you through this. If you're on a tourist visa you'll be able to use the Wise travel currency card to pay for things and withdraw cash at ATM's. There are ATM's available throughout New Zealand so it's easy to access cash.
