ITINERARY & IMPORTANT INFO

DAY 1 - ARRIVE IN PHNOM PENH

• PHNOM PENH Landing in bustling Phnom Penh, we'll meet you at the airport and take you to your hotel, where you'll meet up with your travel crew and get excited for the adventures to come. Tonight we'll then kick things off with dinner and drinks.

DAY 2 - TUK TUK TOUR & CAMBODIAN HISTORY

• PHNOM PENH Today will start with a tuk tuk tour through the colourful, busy streets of Phnom Penh, where you'll get a glimpse into how local people go about their daily routines. We'll then pay a visit to two locations that played a pivotal role in Cambodia's sad and troubled history - the S21 Prison, and the Killing Fields. The stories and history you'll learn here will be difficult, however also necessary to understand Cambodia's past, including the brutal reign of the Khmer Rouge. This evening, dinner, drinks and a night out Phnom Penh style are on the agenda.

DAY 3 - KAYAKING IN KAMPOT

• KAMPOT Swapping city streets for laid back country roads, today we'll travel to the peaceful countryside province of Kampot. After settling in to our cosy traditional guesthouse nestled right by the river, this afternoon we'll travel by kayak, weaving slowly down the river whilst soaking in the tranquil surroundings.

DAY 4 - PEPPER PLANTATION & COOKING CLASS

• KAMPOT Fun fact - Kampot is famed for producing some of the best pepper in the world. We'll be putting that theory to the test this morning as we visit a pepper plantation where our guide will give us a tour of the plantation followed by a cooking class. We'll learn how to make some of Cambodia's most iconic dishes, before heading out on the river for a chilled out sunset cruise.

DAY 5 - HELLO PARADISE

• KOH RONG SANLOEM Never had Cambodia down as much of a beach destination? Just wait until you get to Koh Rong Sanloem! We'll travel by train and fast ferry to reach this paradisiacal island, where we'll be checking in to our island paradise accommodation that is owned by the Chief of the village. This afternoon, feel yourself slipping in to island time as you laze on the beach, beer in hand at the Cliff Bar for sunset.

DAY 6 - SNORKELLING ADVENTURE

• KOH RONG SANLOEM All aboard our private long tail boat to some of the best snorkel spots around the islands, including some beautiful secluded beaches. This evening's sunset will be the perfect time to reflect on another ridiculously awesome day together.

DAY 7 - CHILL OUT & OVERNIGHT BUS

• KOH RONG SANLOEM This morning we'll enjoy our final day on the island relaxing on the beach. We'll then catch the ferry back to the mainland for dinner before boarding an overnight bus bound for Siem Reap. With fully reclining beds and air con, this is bus travelling in style.

DAY 8 - SIEM REAP & FLOATING VILLAGES

• SIEM REAP Arrive in Siem Reap early in the morning. From there we'll venture out to the rural areas and discover some traditional floating villages surrounded by lush rice fields, lotus flowers and flooded forests.

DAY 9 - ANGKOR WAT

• SIEM REAP Saving the best for last, today's the day you'll get to cast eyes on one of the 7 Ancient Wonders of the World. Built in the first half of the 12th century, Angkor Wat is one of the oldest and largest temples in the world. We'll explore the site and learn the history with a Local Guide, and maybe even reenact our favourite Tomb Raider scenes as we visit Ta Prohm, a temple that featured in the movie. Tonight we'll head out for our farewell dinner and final night out!

DAY 10 - DEPART SIEM REAP OR EXTEND YOUR STAY

• SIEM REAP Your unforgettable 10 day adventure comes to an end today. Those flying home will make their way to the airport, or keep living the dream and extend your stay in Cambodia or South East Asia with our help and the new friends you've made.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION It's best to arrive

on the actual start date, as that's when most people get in. While there are no activities on the first day, the group usually meets up for dinner around 7pm. If you do arrive early, we'll still pick you up from the airport if you're staying at our accommodation. You can book and pay for extra nights accommodation in the Manage My Booking area.

AFTER CAMBODIA INTRO

Cambodia Intro finishes in Siem Reap. If you're staying on longer in SE Asia, your group leader will help organise your onward travel including extra nights in Siem Reap and airport transfers. It will take around 1 hour - 90 minutes to get to Siem Reap Airport and will cost around \$15 USD.

VISAS

Most nationalities are able to get a visa on arrival in Cambodia. The visa on arrival for a maximum of 30 days costs approx. \$45 USD and will be payable upon arrival in Cambodia. Some nationalities may need to make advance arrangements.

Please note that while the above information is currently accurate, visa rules can often change so it's always best to double-check before departing.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel insurance for Cambodia is compulsory to join Cambodia Intro. Your group leader will ask to see proof of your cover. You can organise a quote and policy here.



WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO VISIT CAMBODIA?

It's always a good time to go travelling in Cambodia as it's usually warm all year round. There's a slightly higher chance of rain from May to October but that's usually a brief downpour in the afternoon followed by sunshine. The rest of the year is generally hot and dry.



HOW WILL I ACCESS MY MONEY WHILE I'M AWAY?

We recommend getting a travel currency card through Wise. You can use the Wise card almost everywhere and withdraw cash and use it with Google or Apple Pay. If you transfer your money into the local currency, you can avoid paying foreign exchange fees when you use the card. There are ATM's available throughout Cambodia and some places only accept cash.



IS THERE WI-FI THROUGHOUT THE TRIP?

Most of the accommodations we stay at have free Wi-Fi available. Cambodia's network quality is often lower than you're used to but you can generally connect and do basic stuff
